Importance of National Biodiversity Platforms (NBPs)

- important basis for the future of EPBRS after BioStrat financing
- NBPs could have more influence on biodiversity issues at national level
- The network of NPs provides link to EU-level

=national and EU interest



Goals of the Vilnius NBP workshop

- to come up with some practical guidance on how to make NBPs survive under different national conditions
- to see how do successful and active NBPs work
- see possible synergies with Diversitas



Participants

- 24 participants from 19 countries
- + DIVERSITAS

- Questionnaires on NPs filled by 20 partners, + reports diversity of approaches "dormant" NPs

Common mission of NBPs

- 1. Bridging the gap between science and policy
- 2. Support to EPBRS
- 3. Identifying research topics in contributing to research agendas
- 4. Promoting interdisciplinary biodiversity research to support the implementation of biodiversity policies national and European ones
- 5. Scientific support to focal points of international initiatives on biodiversity



Best Practise Report

Minimum requirements of NBPs

- 1. represent members of both the science and policy side
- 2. have a committed secretariat
- 3. adopt an open transfer of information (e.g. website)
- 4. have documented activity related to the common missions
- 5. ensure the active participation of the national scientific community in the EPBRS process



Stategy for self sustainability – ideas, under development

- "adoption" scheme: link bigger platforms to smaller ones (advice, training, visit)
- Shared information of NPs (e.g. IT tools)
- Regional NP networks bilateral links (biogeographic, political similarity etc.)
- Small platforms: list of what is needed, big platforms identify what they can offer



Stategic document – to help approach national authorities (1 page)

- Common effort to help NPs in lobbying and receive support
- Further develop in Slovenia, 2008 January
